Missionary for a Day, or so...

What does it take to become a Missionary? Missionary work comes in all sorts of sizes and shapes. It may be about committing a year or two to working with ecclesias in a particular country. It may be about committing 6 weeks of your Summer Vacation on Truth Corps.

Missionary work is also about Linkman service throughout the year to a mission country: visits, phone calls and e-mails to ecclesias, brothers & sisters. Trips may be about teaching at a Bible School, a weekend Camp or helping to put on a local Preaching Campaign. But they always include doing things to strengthen these small, sometimes isolated ecclesias and visiting brothers and sisters in isolated locations.

CBMA/CBMC are responsible for 44 ecclesias in Latin America and the Caribbean which include over 600 brothers and sisters and over 500 Sunday School members, including about 200 CYC members. There are only 13 Linkmen who do this work and as you can imagine that is a bit of work to keep up with. We are always looking for additional Linkmen and more helpers.

A good way to find out if you might be suited to help as a regular visitor to a mission area, or become involved as a Linkman, is to accompany the Linkman on a planned visit to a particular area of interest. Please consider joining in on one of these trips. Below you will find what is already planned for the rest of this year. Similar plans are ahead for 2016 - please ask us.
